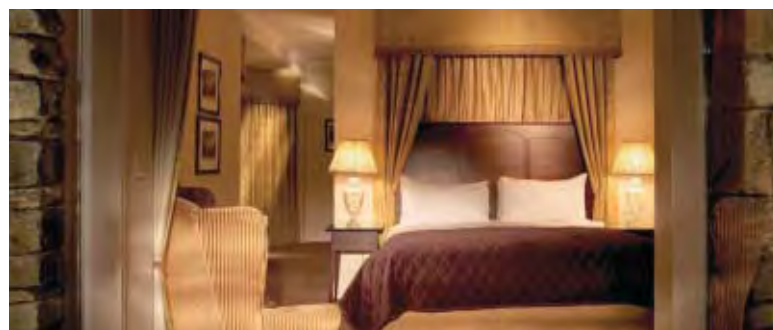
**MACDONALD OLD ENGLAND HOTEL & SPA,  
BOWNESS-ON-WINDERMERE, CUMBRIA**

The historic Macdonald Old England Hotel and Spa, which is just a two minute walk from the nearby Beatrix Potter Museum and Gallery, stands on the shore of Lake Windermere, England's largest lake, and is an ideal base for exploring the Lake District National Park. The grounds of the hotel include mature gardens, with lawns stretching down to the lakeside.

The Lake District, England's largest national park, has occupied a treasured place in the national imagination for centuries, with its breathtaking scenery and diverse wildlife which inspired poets such as William Wordsworth and painters like John Constable.

Other local attractions include lake cruises, Windermere Steamboat Museum, the Aquarium of the Lakes, Lakeland Tours Lakeside & Haverthwaite Railways and the Kirkstone Mountain Pass.

The Annual General Meeting will take place on Friday 29 October, followed by an informal dinner and entertainment. From Friday afternoon onwards there will be a Business Exhibition and a Seminar will be held on Saturday morning. A boat trip on the Lake has been arranged for Saturday afternoon for delegates and ladies wishing to participate.
